2. As an international company we will comply with our statutory duties and obligations, contained within the National OSH legislation & regulations in the countries in which we operate.
3. Our OSH management follow the OAC principles as the means of ensuring that the highest standards of OSH integrate with improved business performance.
4. We recognise that employees and associates have the primary responsibility for OSH in their functional areas and will facilitate their responsibilities through the provision of adequate and appropriate resources.
5. It is our view that accidents are the result of control failures. Accordingly we endeavour to eliminate accidents and lost time incidents from our workplace.
6. We are committed to continually improving our OSH performance therefore we will set challenging, yet achievable, OSH objectives and make arrangements for the regular review of our OSH management system.
7. The Managing Partner will act as the H&S director for the company.
8. All relevant OSH documentation is contained in our Safety Manual and will be available for use by employees and associates.
